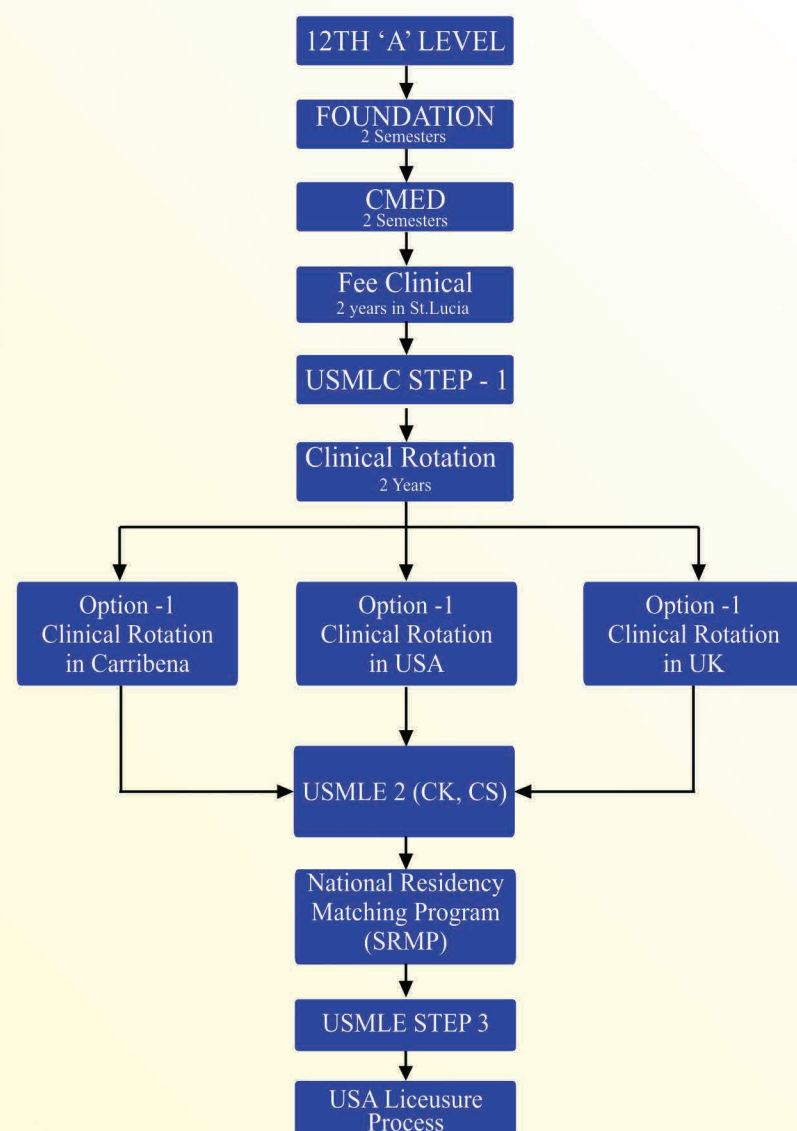

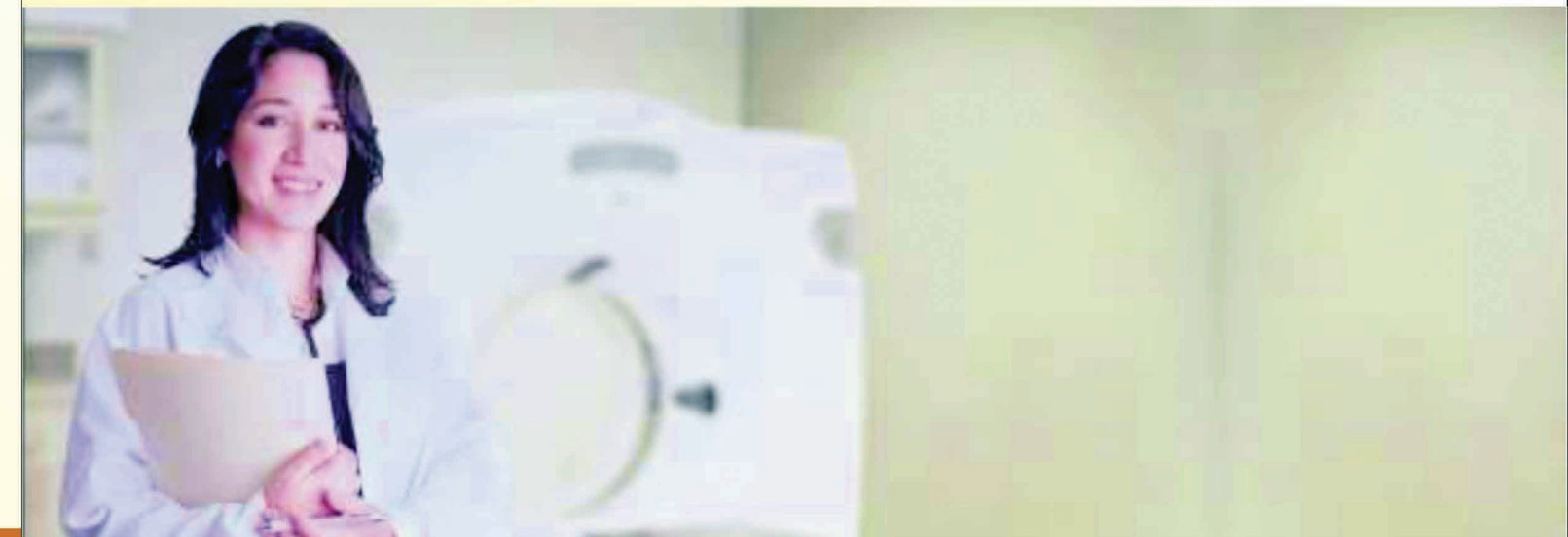

#### MD- Doctor of Medicine 4.5 & 5.5 Years

Doctor of Medicine programs derived mainly from the American Medical Education System. The program is structured in four phases

Duration: The duration of our MD programs 4½ and 5½ years. It has 4 phases

Phase I : Foundation (2 Semesters)

Phase II : CMED (2 Semesters)

Phase III : Pre Clinicals in St. Lucia (2 years)

Phase IV : Clinical rotations in Caribbean or US or UK (2 years)

#### Campus Selection:

All students have to study the first 2 & ½ years Pre-clinicals in St. Lucia Campus. After successful completion of foundation and preclinical (Basic Science) in St. Lucia, students could do the 2 years clinical rotation in the affiliated hospitals either in USA, UK or Caribbean. Based on the individual student's interest and affordability, teaching hospitals will be allotted for the clinical students in USA, UK or Caribbean.

#### Clinical Rotations/Clerkships

For the student to be eligible for the clinical rotations, he/she must have successfully completed the Comprehensive Basic Medical Science Examination conducted by the National Board for Medical Education (NBME) at the end of the 5th Semester of the Basic Medical Science (pre-clinicals) program.

#### Clinical Rotations

The clinical program falls in the final two years of the MD program.

The clinical rotations are performed at hospitals in the United States, UK & Caribbean.

#### The Clinical program in USA

Is conducted at ACGME affiliated teaching hospitals through our clinical administration office located in Maryland, near Washington D.C.

These clinical facilities are state-of-art teaching hospitals under Green Book category. These facilities provide the student with superior clinical exposure that will ensure better career options. To undergo the Clinical Clerkship Program in USA, a student should complete Basic Medical Science Program along with USMLE STEP 1.

The program in Saint Lucia allows such integration to be possible. Students are encouraged to use their knowledge and skills creatively, whether it concerns the human body in health or disease. The prevention of disease and the promotion of good health are considered important aspects in educating a well-rounded physician.

#### The Clinical program in Caribbean :

AIMU has affiliation with the following hospitals for both core and elective rotations.

#### Clinical Affiliation in UK Hospitals :

We have several leading Hospitals in the UK for the clinicals of our students during the final two years of the MD program.

Our Students have an option to do their 2 semesters of Elective Clinicals in India in different leading teaching Hospitals in different cities in India.



### Why study in AIMU in St Lucia, Caribbean country ?

#### WHY STUDY IN A CARIBBEAN MEDICAL SCHOOL ?

- Caribbean Medical students are at a far greater advantage when competing with other International Medical Graduates (IMG's) for US Residency position.
- Residency programs tend to feel more comfortable with students that have been trained in US Hospitals and are familiar with basic procedures and Technologies during their Clinical rotation or Externship in USA at ACGME - Green Book Listed Hospitals. This also gives Caribbean Medical students the benefit of establishing contacts with Doctors and Supervisors during the Clinical years. Those people will not only write your letters of references, but can aid you in obtaining a position in US Residency Program.
- Keep in mind that US Residency Match is much easier for Caribbean Medical Graduates as it has around a 50% IMG match rate, whereas the Canadian match rate for IMG's averages around 10%.

#### INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL GRADUATES (IMG's) - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW?

To participate in Residency Match, International Medical Graduates must have passed all examinations required to obtain certification from the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG). To begin training in a residency program, IMG's must have completed all ECFMG certification requirements which includes.

- Passing scores in Step 1, Step 2 Clinical knowledge (CK) and Step 2 Clinical Skills (CS) of the United States Medical Licensing exam (USMLE), and
- Primary source verification of the IMG's Medical school transcripts

ACGME (Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education) requires IMG's who participate in the residency Match to be ECFMG - certified or to have a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in a US licensing jurisdiction.

#### WHY AIMU?

AIMU places their students in Clinical Rotations or Externship in ACHME - GREEN BOOK Affiliated Hospitals in the US, therefore AIMU students are at a far greater advantage when competing with other International Medical Graduates for US Residency position.

Students those who could not afford to do the Clinical rotation during the final two years of the MD program in USA would still have an option of completing the Pre - Clinicals & Clinical rotation in St. Lucia followed by externship for 1 Semester\* in ACGME - GREEN BOOK Affiliated Hospitals in the US so that our students would have the same advantage when competing with other IMG's as they have been trained in US ACGME - GREEN BOOK Affiliated Hospitals in the US and familiar with US Hospital systems.

AIMU students have a great advantage of doing Clinical Electives in Hospitals in India where they could gain the combination of manual based and system based Clinical knowledge. Also, our students have the option of doing Core & Elective Clinical rotation in one among the renowned and top Medical School "UNIVERSITY OF WEST INDIES - MONA CAMPUS".
